# F. 2023 / 2024 Budget Review

- Budgeting for 13 teams and 192 players
- Preliminary expectation is 3xU11, 2xU13, 1xU15, 2xU15F, 1xU18, 1xU6, U7 and U9

#### Income

- Suggestion to increase fees 5% and add \$55 photo fee
- \$12,000 fundraising revenue goal for an annual event
- \$40K budgeted for gaming grant
- Idea to have a paid director of hockey
- \$25k for sponsor budget (red jersey and banquet)
- \$5K for Whistler CEP budgeted- will find out April 18
- \$4k for Banquet revenue budgeted
- Anticipate \$650 Rep fees
- \$100 Rep Tryout fee

# Expenses

- Similar to this year, but 5% increase to admin, ice scheduler, and RIC
- \$500 Team Genius for evaluators
- Bringing development budgets down to \$2,000 for coach, \$4,400 for goalie, \$18,150 for player, and \$2,000 for referee
- Board to consider Technical Director of Hockey with a budget of \$36K

# G. 2023 / 2024 U15 Integrated Team Formation

- Survey completed by 20/26 players
- 6 will try out for zone team (Hawks)
- 13 players of the 20 would stay for a Whistler Rep (no bears)
- Max 11 players could form a rep team not enough for physical league
- Leaning towards Bears approval for this age group
- Bears A1 and A2, with Squamish agreeing to take a minimum and maximum amount of players to make it work giving 50% of ice, and WMHA retaining a house team
