



## AUTHORIZATION TO VOTE BY PROXY

- (1) A voting member may appoint a proxy holder.
- (2) An appointment of a proxy holder
  - (a) must be in writing and must comply with any other requirements set out in the bylaws,
  - (b) is valid only at the meeting for which the appointment is given or at any adjournment of that meeting, and
  - (c) may be revoked at any time.
- (3) Unless the bylaws provide otherwise, a proxy holder must be a member of the society in good standing.
- (4) Unless limited in the appointment, a proxy holder stands in the place of the voting member appointing the proxy holder and can do anything that member can do, including propose and second resolutions, participate in the discussion and vote.

1. The instrument appointing a proxy must be in the following form:
